

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Topline Evaluation System (TES)

- 1. I don't understand what is causing the problem? I use good feed.**  
Many feeds don't contain sufficient levels of amino acids to support muscle development.
- 2. Which supplement should I use, Top-Line™ Enhance or Top-Line™ Xtreme?**  
This depends upon the rate of improvement. With Top-Line Enhance™, you'll start to see improvement in about 30 days. Top-Line™ Xtreme accelerates the rate of improvement. Top-Line™ Xtreme contains no soy products.
- 3. Do I need to exercise my horse more to fix the topline?**  
While exercise and work conditions the existing muscles on the topline, it has very little to do with "building" the topline area. As the horse's topline develops, the ability of the horse to perform may be determined by how well it is conditioned through exercise.
- 4. Will this make my horse's diet too high in amino acids?**  
No. Top-Line™ supplements are a balanced blend of amino acids. Just follow the feeding directions. These are printed on the label and on our Web site.
- 5. Does a horse with a lower grade have more difficulty performing than a horse with a higher grade?**  
Yes. A lower topline grade means more muscles are deficient. This will impact your horse's ability to perform.
- 6. I don't like to feed soybean meal; do you have something that doesn't contain soy?**  
Top-Line™ Xtreme contains no soy products.
- 7. Are larger breeds, such as thoroughbreds and warm bloods, having a harder time building a topline than stock breeds?**  
Larger breeds have higher amino acid requirements than smaller breeds. In order to develop and maintain adequate muscle, larger breeds should be fed higher levels of amino acids.
